United Way of Ventura County hosts 17th annual Spirit Awards Gala Nonprofit recognizes community champions for their remarkable efforts

(May 6, 2022) — On June 4, 2022, United Way of Ventura County (UWVC) will host its 17th annual Spirit Awards Gala, where it will present awards for volunteerism, community impact and corporate citizenship to local community champions. The event will take place from 6-8:30 p.m. at the Hyatt Regency Westlake, located at 880 S. Westlake Blvd.

This year, Midge Campbell-Thomas, President, Bank of America Ventura/Santa Barbara, will be recognized with the Milton M. Teague Award for Outstanding Community Volunteerism. She is receiving this award for her efforts as a volunteer leader with numerous nonprofit organizations with a focus on addressing social and economic concerns and building strong communities.

Armand Begian, DDS, will be honored with the Douglas Shively Award for Outstanding Community Impact. He was selected for this award due to his dedicated commitment to supporting thousands of children throughout the county with healthy smiles and dental education.

The Roy Pinkerton Award for Top Corporate Citizenship will go to Procter & Gamble for its sixth time.
