

## **DID YOU KNOW?**

To support 1 child, a single-parent in Ventura County needs to earn \$23.96 per hour and with 2 children, \$27.59. Jobs that pay this much generally require advance degrees or specialized skills and experience.

And, in Ventura County, 38% of female households with children ages 5 and under are living below the poverty level, while 27.5% of female households with a high school diploma are living in poverty.
